The Biennial Nationwide Juried Catholic Arts Competition and Exhibition advances and fosters the creation of new artworks by skilled artists working in sacred subject matter. Celebrating the *Via Pulchritudinis* (the way of beauty) as a privileged path in the Church's New Evangelization, the Competition and Exhibition help begin the dialogue between pastors, churches, and devout faithful who wish to commission new and original works of sacred art for liturgical, devotional, and private spaces. The competition awards \$3,500 in prizes.

Elizabeth Lev, Ph.D., the 2018 juror, is an American-born art historian who specializes in Christian art and architecture, Baroque painting and sculpture and High Renaissance art. She is professor of art and architecture for the Italian campuses of Christendom College and Duquesne University, and a licensed guide for the city of Rome and the Vatican Museums. She has served as a Vatican analyst for *NBC* and has appeared on *Today*, *Nightline* and *60 Minutes*. She has also spoken on the arts and humanities at the United Nations and in a TED talk.
